submission deadline:
march 24, 2008

all entries must be submitted in both hard copy and electronic form (with the exception of web design and multimedia, for which no hard copy is necessary). A submission form must be included, which can be found at **www2.gvsu.edu/~vinette**, or picked up at LOH 326.

all hard copies must be submitted to LOH 326 in a manilla envelope with the following written on the front:

- your name
- contact information (phone and email)
- name of the submission
- category of submission

all electronic copies must be submitted to **vinette.info@gmail.com** in one of the following forms:

- cd-rom
- PDF sent by email
- word document sent by email

categories:

print design:

documents in this category can range from newsletters and brochures to advertisements. there must be some sort of design element in the pieces. the copy does not have to be original, but the design must be.

web design:

web design pieces can range from an entire website to an individual web page. the pieces must be original or collaborative work.

professional documents:

many types of documents are included in this category. all documents must be original and must be a form of professional communication. types of documents include memos, news releases, academic essays, journalistic news stories, and more.

multimedia:

multimedia pieces can include flash, video production, or other interactive mediums.

creative non-fiction:

these pieces have a factual basis, but the author is permitted artistic licenses with his or her portrayal of facts. these often take the forms of memoirs, but can be in a variety of forms and presented in a serious or lighthearted manner.
