Heart disease is the leading cause of death in women. Spreading this information is vital for women's health. Young women also need to learn the information early to take preventative steps and to have a healthy lifestyle. Daughters, relatives, and friends will also be encouragement for other women to live a healthy life and participate in the Go Red campaign.
